Background: Forced displacement in Jerusalem



Mission Statement

- Accessing and building on other existing rightsbased organizations in order to develop the basic, essential civic capacity needed in order to empower Palestinian civil society at all levels.


Main Issues in Jerusalem Issue 1: Residency



Residency issues in Jerusalem:

- Residency Revocation
 - **14,500 (1967 2015)**
- Family Unification
- Child Registration
 - 10,000 child unregistered

Zoning - Israeli Municipal conduct in East Jerusalem



- **Expropriated for Israeli Settlements**
- Zoned for Palestinian Construction (9.18 SQ KM)
- Unplanned Areas

Al-Quds University's intervention: Pro-bono Legal Services in Jerusalem

Community Action Center



Established: 1999 in the old city Currently representing hundreds of Palestinians on a variety of legal issues

Al-Quds Human Rights Clinic



Established: 2006

The first clinical legal education program in

the Arab world.

Trained and graduated dozens of students.

Professional lawyers working with students serving the community



- Legal Clinic is an accredited course in the law school.
- Students get 6 credits in a course that runs through a whole academic year (Sep through May)
- Students are supervised by academics and professional lawyers
 Together giving legal services



Al-Quds University guarantees the sustainability of its legal services through supporting the CAC and the Clinic indefinitely. We also fundraise to improve our services and make them more sustainable.

Examples of services

Example 1: An old city bakery



Occupation authorities claim that bakery has no license to bake, although the bakery is older than the occupation itself.

AQU intervened legally and eventually occupation authorities recognized the existing license.



Example 2: Al-Murabitat

Group of non-violent demonstrators in Al-Aqsa Mosque. Israeli authorities punished them with revoking their membership in the social welfare system including medical insurance.

We intervened and succeeded to reclaim the membership in every case we took.



Collective punishment case

Nadia Abu Jamal's children suffered a punitive revoking of their me membership in the social welfare and medical insurance institution because their father was shot in a shooting incident.

AQU managed to reclaim their social welfare membership in the court.
