

Trafficking in human beings crime

Abstract

The study dealt with the provisions of the crime of trafficking in human beings in accordance with the provisions of international law. The concept of the crime of trafficking in human beings was recognized by jurists and in domestic legislation and international conventions. The main characteristics of these crimes were identified. To the provisions of international law, and then identify the factors causing the crime and its consequences .

The international efforts to combat the crime of trafficking in human beings have been identified by identifying the role of international organizations and international conventions in combating this crime. Regional efforts have also been identified in combating the crime of human trafficking through the identification of the most important regional conventions dealing with the provisions of the crime of trafficking in human beings , And also identified the most important control measures in accordance with those conventions. The national efforts to combat the crime of trafficking in human beings were also identified by identifying the position of the Palestinian legislator on the crime of trafficking in human beings and identifying the mechanisms proposed to combat them

Several results have been reached on the crime of human trafficking, notably the lack of special legislation in Palestine to combat trafficking in human beings. Palestine has not acceded to all international conventions related to trafficking in human beings and there is no Palestinian strategy to combat such crime. The researcher recommended a number of recommendations, including the need to issue special Palestinian legislation to combat the crime of trafficking in human beings, and the need for a Palestinian to adhere to all international conventions related to the crime of trafficking in human beings and to form a committee or a national supreme body to combat this crime.
