## Abstract

This study aims at investigating the role of small and medium Enterprises in women empowerment in Palestine, to make the attempt a successful one, this study, Further, reviewed the existing relevant literature along with some theoretical ideas in relation to mark the women empowerment by small and medium enterprises, and present the results and recommendations and procedures needed by decision makers, to shed light on effective ways to achieve women empowerment by SMES.

Toward that end, the study applied exploratory descriptive method; A random sample of (58) responders was adopted in this study. To collect the data needed for this study, a questionnaire of main parts was designed with taking reliability and validity into consideration for analysis of data SPSS.
