Abstract

The study aims to identify the behavioral disorders among the children of

drug addicts from the mother perspective; the researcher used the analytical

descriptive method by measuring behavioral disorders among the children of

drug addicts from their mother perspective. The researcher used in his

selection of the study a random sample so the sample will be used as a

representative of the community. The sample is consisted of (109) mothers

of children of drug addicts. The validity of the study tool has been verified

by presenting it to a group of specialized arbitrators through calculating

correlation coefficients between the vertebrates and the total score was (95%).

The study found that the behavioral disorders of the children of drug addicts

through their mother perspective were high.

It was found that there are no statistically significant differences in the

responses of the respondents. The level of behavioral disorders among the children of drug addicts from the perspective of the family is attributed due to the variable of place of residence, age, social status, number of family

members, economic level of the family, scientific qualification, mother's

work and head of household.

While there are statistically significant differences in the responses of the respondents, the level of behavioral disorders among the children of drug addicts from the perspective of the family is attributed to the father's work variable, and the differences were in favor of the unemployed.

Based on the previous results, the researcher recommends to study behavioral problems individually according to their importance and impact on the child and how to deal with them, also to study the long-term effects of addiction on children in the future and on their behavior also Conducting a indicative programs based on the results of the study, And that community institutions seek to separate drug addicts from their children And to treat them so that their behavior is not affected negatively.
