

# **Rules and Guidelines of Islamic Jurisprudence Extracted from Kamal Addin Ibn Al-Humam's Fath Al-Qadir Worship (Ibadat) Chapter**

## **Abstract**

This thesis studies part of the Hanafi Imam and scholar's fiqh, Kamal Addin Ibn Al-Humam, that is presented in Worship (Ibadat) Chapter of his book, Fath Al-Qadir. This thesis aims at collecting and showing the rules and guidelines (dhawabet) of jurisprudence that Ibn Al-Humam has mentioned and used in setting Fiqh rules.

I have collected and explained twenty-five rules and three guidelines using the inductive method throughout my research. Moreover, I have explained the worship (Ibadat) issues that Ibn Al-Humam has extracted depending on the related rule and guideline in his book. I have also explained his perspective and his school's alongside with other jurists' perspectives regarding the same issues.

The thesis concludes that Ibn Al-Humam has given his fiqh rules and guidelines a great importance in the extraction of the rules and regulations. One of the most important conclusions to be mentioned here is that most of Ibn Al-Humam's perspectives do correspond with his Hanafi school perspectives. More conclusions are to be mentioned in the conclusion part of the thesis.

Finally, I recommend that Islamic jurisprudence library , in terms of manuscripts in particular, should be computerized and developed. I also recommend that students should study the fiqh rules and guidelines in the other chapters of Fath Al-Qadir.
