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Abstract:

The researcher proved in her study, and after the extrapolation of many texts of Islamic law, that removing controversy surrounding Islamic jurisprudence must be according to a destination characterized by the following:

Firstly, that it is a definite destination.

Secondly, that it is a complementary destination for other destinations.

Thirdly, it is a complementary necessities destination when it comes to communities, and a complementary need and desirability destination when it comes to individuals.

The researcher presented in this study methods and rules to eliminating controversy on Islamic jurisprudence, which include: Islamic legal text, consensus, considering controversy, the judge's judgment, the ruler's judgment, and modern technology.

The study concluded with many results, including: the scholar must aim to reduce controversy surrounding jurisprudence branches, with the goal of removing controversy, which the Islamic law aimed to do.

The recommendations are as follows: to advise the jurisprudence branches, and the known Islamic bodies to reconsider the issue which have controversy, and to aim to reduce its controversy as much as possible, according to the ways and rules cited in the study.
