Abstract:

The study aimed to Reality of pioneering Culture and its Relationship to the Other Pioneering Dimensions in the College of Applied Professions. The case study of the College of Applied Professions/Polytechnic University of Palestine. The descriptive approach was used. The size of the study population was about 84 employees and 2484 students. (98%) and students (91%). The researcher found the following results: The pioneering culture and the dimensions of leadership in the Palestinian universities are from (28%) to (28) employees and (104) male and female students. The view of employees and students at the College of Applied Professions at Polytechnic University The results showed that the level of creativity and innovation in the Palestinian universities from the perspective of the employees of the College of Applied Professions at the Polytechnic University of Palestine came to a medium level, while it was high for the students. The results showed that the level of risk in Palestinian universities from the point of view of students and employees In the College of Applied Professions at the Polytechnic University of Palestine came at a medium level, and that the level of competitiveness in Palestinian universities from the perspective of students and employees of the Faculty of Applied Professions at the Polytechnic University of Palestine came to a high degree and that the level of independence in the university The level of the leading culture in the Palestinian universities from the perspective of the employees of the College of Applied Professions at the Polytechnic University of Palestine came to a high level, while the average of the students came, and the results showed that There is a statistically significant effect between the pioneering culture, creativity and innovation from the perspective of students in the College of Applied professions in the Polytechnic of Palestine, while there is no statistically significant effect between the pioneering culture, risk, competitiveness and independence from the perspective of students in the college Applied occupations in Palestine Polytechnic. The results showed that there is no statistically significant effect between the pioneering culture, creativity, innovation and independence from the perspective of the employees of the College of Applied professions in the Polytechnic of Palestine, while

there is a statistically significant effect between the pioneering culture and the risk and competitiveness from the perspective of the employees of the Faculty of Applied professions in Polytechnic Palestine , And the results showed that there were no statistically significant differences in the responses of the sample members on the effect of pioneering culture on the dimensions of leadership in Palestinian universities from the point of view of students in the Faculty of Applied Professions at Polytechnic University of Palestine The results showed that there were no statistically significant differences in the responses of the study sample members on the effect of pioneering culture on the dimensions of leadership in Palestinian universities from the perspective of students in the Faculty of Applied professions at the Polytechnic University of Palestine due to gender variable, Years of experience, while there were differences in the variable department in which the teacher works for the Department of Administrative Sciences and Engineering.
